MOTION was made to enter executive session at 8:34 PM by Trustee Davis to discuss personnel concerns, seconded by Deputy Mayor Snyder. Carried 5-0.

MOTION to exit executive session at 9:05 PM was made by Trustee Piper, seconded by Trustee Davis. Carried 5-0.

MOTION to accept the following wages for the upcoming fiscal year 2026-2027 was made by Trustee Piper, Seconded by Trustee Mann. Carried 5-0

MOTION was made by Trustee Davis to hold a Public Hearing on April 6th at 10:00 am at the Government Center. Seconded by Trustee Piper. Carried 5-0

MOTION was made by Trustee Mann to limit overtime to the following: call-outs, snow plowing, weekends on call, and to flex work schedule to adjust for overtime. Seconded by Trustee Davis. Carried 5-0

MOTION was made to appoint Kimberly Wester as the Clerk/Treasurer for the Village of Nunda for 1 year commencing April 1, 2026 by Trustee Mann, Seconded by Trustee Piper. Carried 5-0.

MOTION was made by Trustee Piper to appoint Susan Hall as an advisor to the Clerk/Treasurer and Board of Trustees for the remainder of the current fiscal year and also the upcoming 2026-2027 fiscal year. Seconded by Trustee Mann. Carried 5-0.

MOTION to rescind the privileges for the use of the Village vehicle by the Chief Sewer Operator for use of home to work was made by Trustee Piper. Seconded by Trustee Davis. Carried 5-0.

MOTION to *NOT* renew the probationary period of 8 ½ hour work days Monday - Thursday and 6 hours on Friday for the Chief Sewer Operator was made by Trustee Mann, Seconded by Trustee Davis. Work hours as of 4/6/26 will be Monday through Friday 8 hours each day. Carried 5-0.

MOTION to create a committee for the Nunda Village Hall upgrades that will consist of a Nunda Village Board Member, 2 Community Members, and the donor as an Ex-Officio was made by Trustee Mann, Seconded by Trustee Davis. Carried 3-0.

MOTION was made by Trustee Davis to appoint Patty Piper as the Nunda Village Board Member for the Nunda Village Hall Committee. Seconded by Trustee Mann. Carried 4-0.

MOTION was made by Trustee Davis to appoint Jack Morgan and Darren Snyder as the 2 Community Members for the Village Hall Committee. Seconded by Trustee Piper. Carried 3-0.

MOTION was made by Trustee Davis for Darren Snyder to connect to the water/sewer on Route 408, with the approval of the Superintendent of the Water Department, if the way be clear. Seconded by Trustee Mann. Carried 4-0.
